Curriculum Overview EYFS Term 1

Topic: 'Getting to Know Me' with a focus on Nursery Rhymes

Physical development

This term the children will be encouraged to use the cutlery carefully and with control when eating their school dinner. The children will be practise their balance, coordination and control through challenges placed in our outside area, as well as negotiating space and speed.

Understanding of the world

This term we will be talking about ourselves and our families. We will begin to notice the changes in the season and learn all about Autumn, collecting acorns and doing bark rubbings.

Communication and language

We are going to be listening to lots of stories and will be encouraging the children to make predictions about what they think will happen next. We will be practising speaking in full sentences to describe what they have been learning.

Mathematics

This term we will be singing songs involving number. We will confidently count 5 objects and being introduced to each of the numerals.

Expressive Art and Design

The children will be taught how to join materials together to make something new, as well as use paint effectively. We will be singing lots of nursery rhymes and songs as well as using instruments to create their own songs. The children will be exploring colour by mixing them together to make new colours.
