Top Tips for Attendance

Of all the key elements to achieving well at school, attendance has to be the most basic.

1. Establish basic routines, like waking up time, that will help your child develop good attendance habits.
2. Get everything ready for school the night before: uniform, homework, PE kit, packed lunch, etc., so that your child has everything they need for the day. Check if there are any letters from school and anything that needs a signature.
3. Talk to your child regularly about why going to school every day is important. Set a good example yourself, so your child can see your own commitment to being on time for work and appointments.

Being On Time

Being in school on time is a positive start to the day. It helps your child get the most from their education and can lead to greater achievement and success. It also stops your child from feeling awkward if they are walking into a lesson that has already started. When your child is late and are school dinners, this has can have impact on their meal choice as the dinner register is taken promptly at **8:40am**

Year 2 have had lots of fun this term learning how to play the boomwhackers in music.

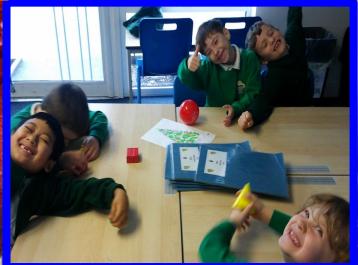
We also enjoyed designing and then decorating gingerbread men in Design and Technology!

From all the staff in KS1, we hope you have a wonderful Christmas and we look forward to seeing you all in the New Year!



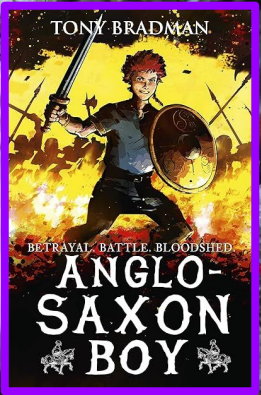
Term 2 - Years 3 & 4

Children should be reading daily for 20 minutes. This needs to be entered in their reading record.

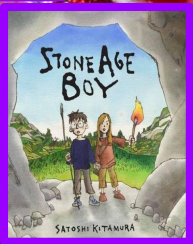
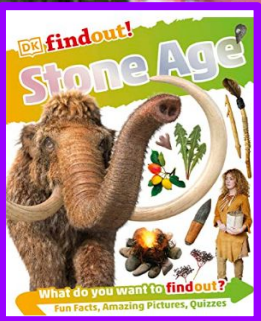
