Year 3 Term 4



Topic: **Oceania**

English

We will be reading Information Texts about Oceania. We will be writing Travel Brochures, leaflets, writing descriptions and postcards. Making sure the children are aware of the features of these.

Science

To continue researching plants, exploring the life cycle of a plant, how seeds are dispersed and pollination process.

D.T

Create 3d models of the Great Barrier Reef fish and plants out of card and clay.

Computing

We will be learning about branching databases. We will look at how to categorise to make groups, how to create yes/no questions and how to prove our own branching databases work.

Music

We will be listening to different genres of music, improvising and composing simple tunes and performing these.

To revise colours and be able to name a variety of animals.

Maths

Continue to explore measurement, looking at comparing and ordering lengths as well as adding and subtracting. Year 3 will then move onto fractions. Looking at equivalent fractions, and different ways fractions can be shown.

Geography

Where is Antarctica, what is climate like, where is it and what you can find there. We will look at Shackleton and his expedition and plan our own expedition around School.

PSHE

Look at healthy living and what factors affect these and what encourages our bodies to be healthy.

Look at how Christians use bible stories and why and how they celebrate Easter.

Look at the Great Barrier Reef and create fish and plant observational drawing and collages
