Personal, social and emotional development

Children will continue to identify how they are feeling using our feelings charts. They will talk about ways they can keep their bodies healthy e.g. through sleeping, healthy eating, exercise, etc.

Literacy

This term the children will be reading lots of new texts about our Fantasy topics (Princesses, dragons, knights, etc), including stories and non-fiction books. We will be writing simple short sentences and ensuring they are using their phonics knowledge.

Physical development

In PE children will continue to be taught to develop and refine a range of ball skills including throwing, catching, kicking, passing, batting and aiming. We will continue to embed the daily routines including lining up, queuing up and meal times.

Understanding of the world
This term will be describe what they see, hear and feel whilst outside. To understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around us. We will be comparing our lives to others, including Vikings and what it would be like to live in a Castle.

Communication and language

Children will continue to be introduced to a wide range of new vocabulary, which they will learn through stories and be encouraged to use throughout their play. They will be encouraged to ask questions to find out more information.

Mathematics

Children will begin to build numbers beyond 10 and look at patterns within these numbers. We will be learning to add more and begin to look at subtraction with numbers within 10.

Expressive Art and Design

This term children will be looking at creating their own designs and also evaluating these too. We will be designing and creating our own broomsticks like in 'Room on the Broom'. We will be singing a nursery rhyme a week linked to each book we read.
