Curriculum Overview

Science

Our Topic for this term is 'Animals including Humans". During the course of this term we will look study the function of the skeleton and muscles in humans and some animals, We will then move on and look at the different types of teeth that humans have and their simple functions. We will finish our Science lessons this term by studying the human digestive system and the function of the different parts.

Maths

Decimals - recognising tenths and hundredths, tenths and hundredths as decimals, writing decimals, rounding, comparing and ordering as well as dividing 1 and 2 digit numbers by 10 and 100

Money - understanding pounds and pence, ordering and estimating, converting £ to pence, adding and subtracting amounts and finding change.

Time - telling the time to the nearest minute and 5 minute interval, using a 24 hour clock, converting analogue to digital (12 and 24 hour)

We will also be continuing to practice multiplication facts throughout the term.

HISTORY

This term we will be looking at how children's lives have changed over time. We will study a range of sources to help us draw conclusions about different changes. We will look at what life was like for Tudor children and how it differs from the lives of children today. We will also look at the different jobs that children undertook in Victorian England and what illnesses and diseases children succumbed to. We will study how the work of Lord Shaftesbury changed children's lives for the better and how this impacted on children's leisure time today.
