Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a busy and exciting year here at Beaver Green. The children have taken part in many different learning experiences, including school trips, workshops in school and of course everyone enjoyed Sports Day.

I would like to take this opportunity to share with you our fantastic results that we have achieved this year at Beaver Green. Every year we take part in a number of assessments, Year 6 SATS, the phonics screen and children in EYFS are assessed to see if they have made a good level of development. All of these assessments are sent off to the local authority and the government. The government provides us with the number of children nationally who passed these assessments. Currently, the national figures are only provisional, but are unlikely to change. In the table on the next slide, I have outlined our results alongside the national figures.

I would also like to thank the PTFA for all their hard work this year in providing exciting events for the children and raising money for the school. A special thank you to Gemma who works endlessly to arrange and organise a variety of events. A massive well done to 22 pupils who had the perfect 100% attendance score for the whole year.

Congratulations to the 190 pupils who hit our attendance target of 96% and over for the year.

Attendance Action Plan for next school year:

We must improve our overall attendance levels to be in line with the national average and aim for 95% for the next academic year.

Each child to aim for an individual score of at least 96%.

Our persistent absence levels remain too high and need to be addressed. **23%** of our school pupils were persistently absent, meaning that they were absent for 19 or more days during the year.

We will continue to develop incentives to raise the awareness of why school attendance is so important to both pupils and parents/carers.
