Term 3 - Years 1 & 2



Year 2 have had a brilliant term learning all about plants! We have written our own seed planting instructions, descriptive garden pieces and even planted our own seeds!

Year 2 had a fantastic trip this term to Singleton Environment Centre. The children explored native plants and trees, creating their own information booklets and taking part in a scavenger hunt! They also investigated which parts of plants are edible and which seasons different fruits and vegetables grow.



Term 3 - Years 3 & 4



Year 4 have enjoyed making their own model Pantheon (Temple of the Gods) during Art this term. The children had to design and build their own temples with recycled materials.

Year 3 have enjoyed learning about Tu B'Shevat which is a Jewish festival. Tu B'Shevat means 'New Year of the Trees.' We created our own tree pictures using oil and chalk pastels to create this fantastic display!



Term 3 - Years 5 & 6



Year 5 have explored traditional Chinese paintings and calligraphy. They have painted trees, bamboos and flowers, even wrote some Chinese characters with Chinese brushes- 毛笔 máo bǐ. Amazing work!
