Uniform

At Beaver Green we expect all children from Year R to 6 to wear the correct uniform. The school uniform is optional for our children in the Nursery.

Uniform can be purchased from County Print and Embroidery. Chapel Mews, North Street, Ashford TN24 8JN 01233 367867.

Requirements:

- White shirt or polo shirt
- Green jumper or cardigan with the school logo - no other shades of green are permitted
- Grey or black tailored skirt, pinafore or trousers in the winter months
- Green and white checked dress or grey or black formal shorts in the summer months
- Plain black shoes with a low (less than 3cm) heel
- White, grey, black or green socks/tights
- Children are permitted to wear a pair of small stud earrings and a watch only

P.E kit

- All pupils must have a named P.E kit in school at all times.
- House-colour T-shirt
- The House Colours are:
 - Blue for Farah House
 - Green for Hill House
 - Red for Moore House
 - Yellow for Storey House
- Green shorts
- Dark colour tracksuit can be worn in the winter months for outside P.E.
- Green or black plimsolls or trainers.
- All children will be given an 'active wear' jacket when they start in a new class. These will be kept in school.

Forest School

All children will take part in Forest School. For this they will require:

- Wellies
- Old warm clothing
- A water proof coat

OPAL play

We are an OPAL play school, which means all children will have the opportunity for exciting play opportunities at lunchtimes. We do try and get out in all weather conditions so for this children will

require:

- Wellies
- Old warm clothing to change into for lunchtimes
- A water proof coat
- Water proof trousers if possible

Other Uniform Information

- Items used for Forest School can also be used for OPAL play - there is no need to buy two of everything.
- Hair shoulder-length or longer is to be tied back.
- No makeup or nail varnish is to be worn.
- All jewellery is to be removed for P.E. lessons for health and safety reasons.
- Please note the beginning of summer holidays is the best time to have your child's ear pierced.
