Term 3

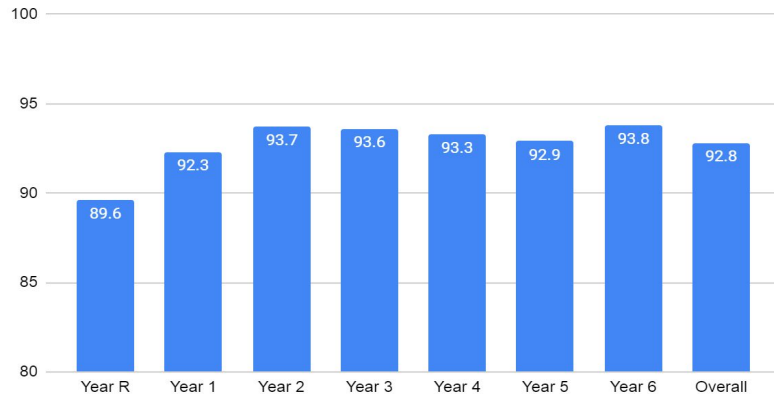
We return to school for the start of Term 3 on Tuesday 4th January 2022.

Our overall attendance for the year to date is 92.8%.

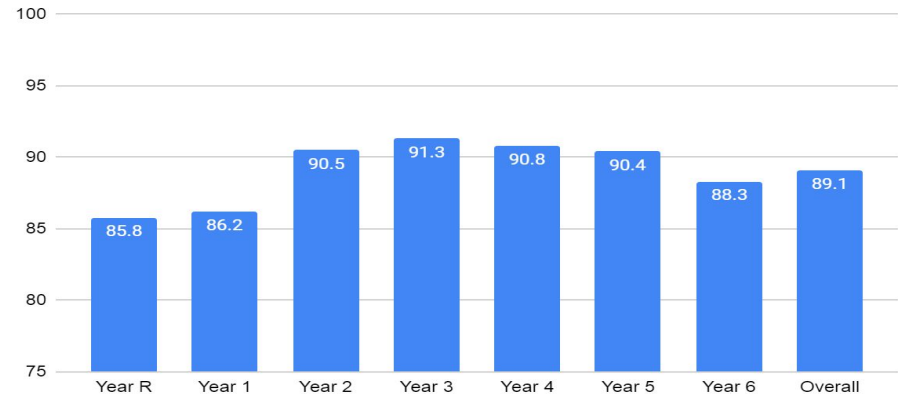
Year to date

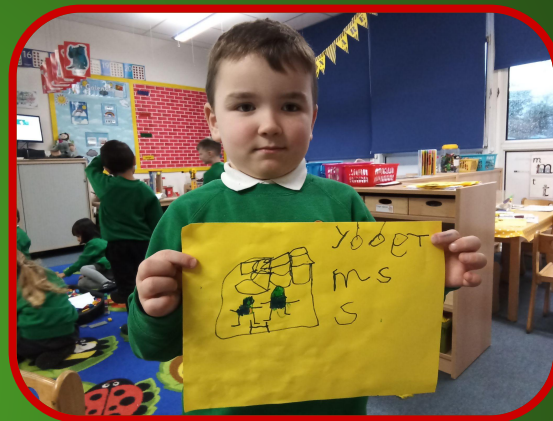
Star of the Week - Nursery

Star of the Week - Year 2



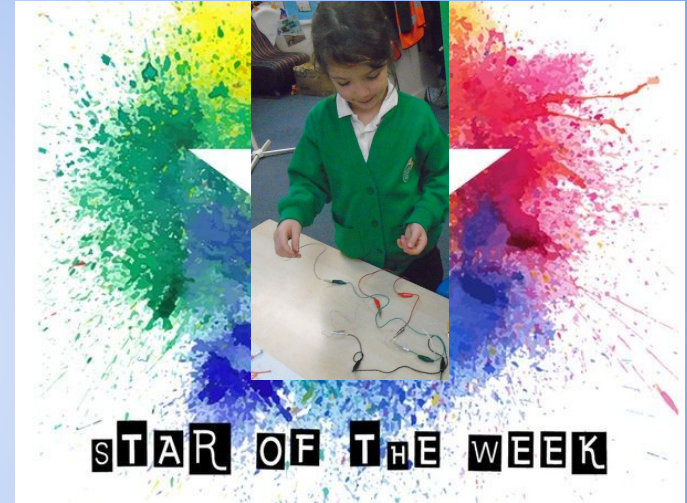
Star of the Week for Wiesner Class goes to Thomas for trying his best with his Maths. Well done!
