Year 6 Residential

It's that time of year again when we are busy planning the end of Year 6 Residential Trip. This year we are going to Ferny Crofts Activity Centre in Hampshire. We have booked to go on Monday 8th June to Friday 12th June 2026.

We understand that the cost of these trips are expensive. However we would love for all children in Year 6 to take part in this activity week. We understand that the cost of these trips are expensive and the PTA have agreed to help with the cost of this trip by donating £2000 towards the expenses.

The total costs to parents for this trip will be £380.

The cost of this trip covers all travel expenses, full bed and board for the week and a crammed packed week of fun filled activities such as, high wires, go karts, leap of faith, tomahawk throwing and much more.

If you are interested in your child taking part in the trip there is a non refundable deposit of £45 which must be **paid no later than Wednesday 20th November 2025**. There will then be monthly instalments for the remainder of the total, these will be £56 per month from 20th December - 20th April with the last instalment of £55 due on 20th May 2026.

Once the deposit has been received you are obliged to meet the payments on the instalment plan. If at a later date your child decides that they no longer want to attend the trip and you wish to withdraw them please let us know via email - bgpoffice@swale.at you may not be entitled to a full refund this will depend on the costs incurred to the school from the venue.

If your child chooses not to attend the trip and to remain at school for the week, this will be a normal school week for the children and staff in school.

If you would like your child to take part in the trip but are experiencing financial difficulties please speak to the office staff in the first instance.
