Dear Parents and Carers,



Thank you for continued support.



The deadline to apply for Reception places is Monday 17th January. If you need any help applying please contact the office.





















Star of the Week - Nursery



Star of the week in Nursery is Daisy. Daisy was able to recognise all the numbers on the number fan without any support. Well done Daisy.












Star of the Week - Reception













Ella has also been extremely helpful around the classroom this week by offering to do lots of tasks such as collecting in books, or laptops and is always very kind and supportive with other students in the class.




