celebration

a **happy time** when people come together to enjoy and remember something important, like a birthday or a festival

tradition

a **special way of doing things** that people have done for a long time, often **passed down** in families or communities

community

a **group of people** who belong together or share **something in common**, like a school, a neighbourhood, or a church

symbol

an **object, picture, or action** that stands for **something else**, like a heart standing for love or a candle standing for light

promise

when you **say you will** do something and **mean it**

altar

a **special table** at the front of a church where important parts of **worship** happen, such as sharing bread and wine in **Holy Communion**

special times for Christians

baptism

a Christian ceremony where someone is welcomed into the church family

water is used to show a new beginning and belonging



Holy Communion

a Christian service where bread and wine (or grape juice) are shared to remember the special meal Jesus had with his friends, called the Last Supper



marriage

in Christianity, marriage is a lifelong promise between two people made before God
