As you will be aware we had some issues with our gas supply this week, this has now been resolved and all services have been restored and lunches have returned to normal.



Holi is also known as the "festival of colours".





As we are Ladybird class Elena was very excited to find a Ladybird on our Peg dolls outside. Well spotted Elena.





Our star of the week this week is Arthur for his fabulous Maths work! You always work so hard!






The Star of the Week in Bright Class this week is Kelsey for being a kind and caring member of the class and always trying her best and working hard!


