#### **Government Mobile Phone Alert**

A test alert will be sent, by the government, to all UK mobile phones (and potentially tablets) on **April 23rd 2023.** 

The Emergency Alert will appear on the home screen of your device and you will hear a loud siren-like sound and feel a vibration for up to 10 seconds.

#### Even if the device is on silent.

If you're a survivor of domestic abuse with a secret or secondary phone this alert could reveal the existence and location of the device.

## Term 4 - 2NB


This term our focus topic is Rainforests.




