
Congratulations to all the children who were invited to the Headteacher's Tea Party. They all had a lovely time and enjoyed all the crips and chocolate treats.

In Science we have been studying living things and habitats. We explored the outside to see what habitats and animals we could find!










Term 5 - 4PA

Some of the boys and girls have been getting into Rubik's cubes - We are learning how to solve them as a bit of fun! We may even start a club.








Term 5 - 4EB


Term 5 - 5BM

In Computing we have been using selection on Scratch to create a quiz!










Term 5 - 6AT

We started our project by creating a spiral using concentric circles and dividing them into 6 equal sections of 60° We also created a Baravelle spiral using squares. We will be moving on and creating Fibonacci spirals.
