# Summer Holiday Activities

**A family-friendly Dino Trail is heading to Ashford Town Centre this August!**

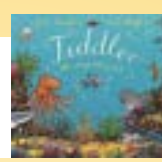

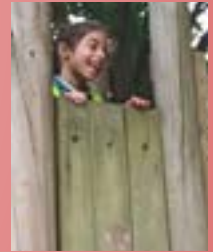

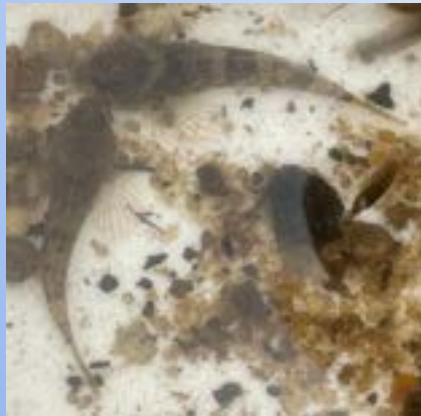


In 2NB we made cards for Dads' and other special people in our lives. As we think these people are so cool we made them all an ice-cream picture from handprints!

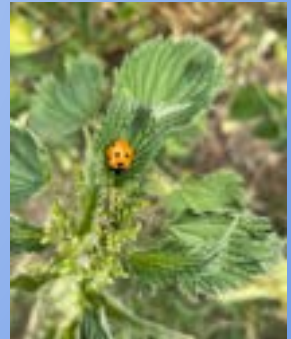
We used fishing nets, plastic trays and magnifying glasses to do our river dipping and identifying.

This term we had a trip to the River Stour where we looked at what lived there. We got to do a bit of river dipping.

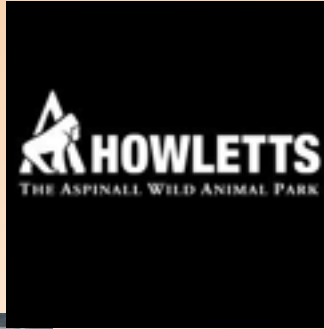

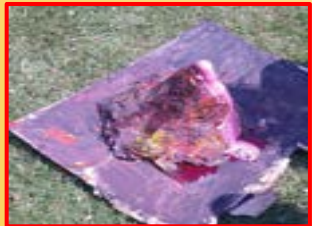
