Year 1 had a fantastic time participating in Animate Arts' Big Draw Festival 2020 throughout October and November. We produced sea swallows that we stuck together to form a flock. We made curtains by creating snowflakes. We also listened to Carol of the Bells and used candle wax to draw on white paper to show the movements we heard. Then we painted over them using watery blue paint to create the waves in the sea! Finally we designed 2 arctic foxes that were made into cardboard cutouts. 


